CONTRACT TYPE Multiple award, performance-based, Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) with Cost-Plus-Fixed-Fee (CPFF) and Firm Fixed-Price (FFP) task orders.

PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE Five (5) year ordering period from date of award on 23 September 2020.

CEILING VALUE \$113,800,000.00 with an option to extend to \$125,800,000.00.

LOCATIONS Navy and Marine Corps shore facilities worldwide (CONUS and OCONUS), Southwest Asia, other sovereign and foreign government and commercial facilities.

SECURITY CLEARANCES Up to SECRET level task orders.

APPROVED SUBCONTRACTORS New subcontractors may be proposed at the task order level. Upon award, the subcontractor is automatically approved for use on any current/future task orders.

COMPETITION Both competitive and non-competitive (sole source) task orders are contemplated. Each contract holder is limited to a cumulative value of \$4M in sole source orders.
